# Library Board Meeting August 15, 2023

### Secretary's Report:

## Treasurer's Report:

The bills for August total 21,958.99. Joan moved to pay the bills for August and Mary seconded. Motion passed.

In our regular account we have \$371,722.84 and in our reserve account we have \$326,520.78 for a total of \$698,243.62.

## **Library Director's Report:**

July circulation—15,350 Patrons—2,903 Door Count—2,799

- a. Received Penal Fine check from Oakland County of \$19,722.10. Last year we received \$21,970.20 and we budgeted \$25,000.00 a shortfall of \$5,277.90.
- b. Summer Reading ended on August 4<sup>th</sup> we will have statistics next month.

#### Old Business:

A patron asked if we had a mask policy and we do not. We had one during covid as the Health Department and MIOSHA required. We have a couple of staff members that wear masks but it is for medical reasons. Also some staff have been wearing a mask if they are ill or return to work after having covid. I polled several libraries and no one had a mask policy. The Board felt that a policy was not necessary that it is a matter of personal choice and does not interfere with their job duties.

#### **New Business:**

Kristy moved to levy 0.3989 and 0.4781 millages for budget year 2024. Kathy seconded. Motion carried. Cathy will forward the signed L-4029 form to the Township and County.
